Fraudsters are getting smarter, but so are we. In Canada, scams cost victims millions every year. From phishing emails to phone scams, staying informed is your best defense.

Top Tips to Prevent Fraud



- ✓ Beware of "urgent" requests – Scammers create pressure by saying you must act immediately. Take time to verify.
- ✓ Don't trust caller ID alone – Fraudsters can "spoof" numbers to look legitimate. Hang up and call the official number.
- ✓ Avoid sending money or gift cards to anyone claiming to be from the government, a bank, or a family member in trouble.
- ✓ Watch out for prize or lottery scams – If you didn't enter, you didn't win.
